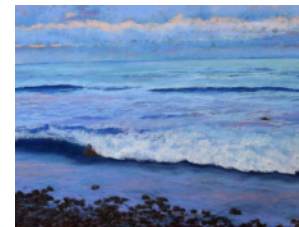


6 Deborah Maxwell- Pottery
